stride and live for the good ones.

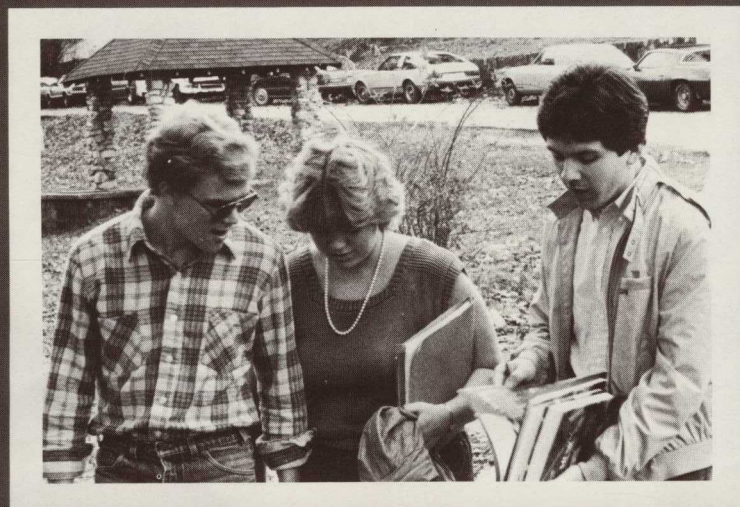






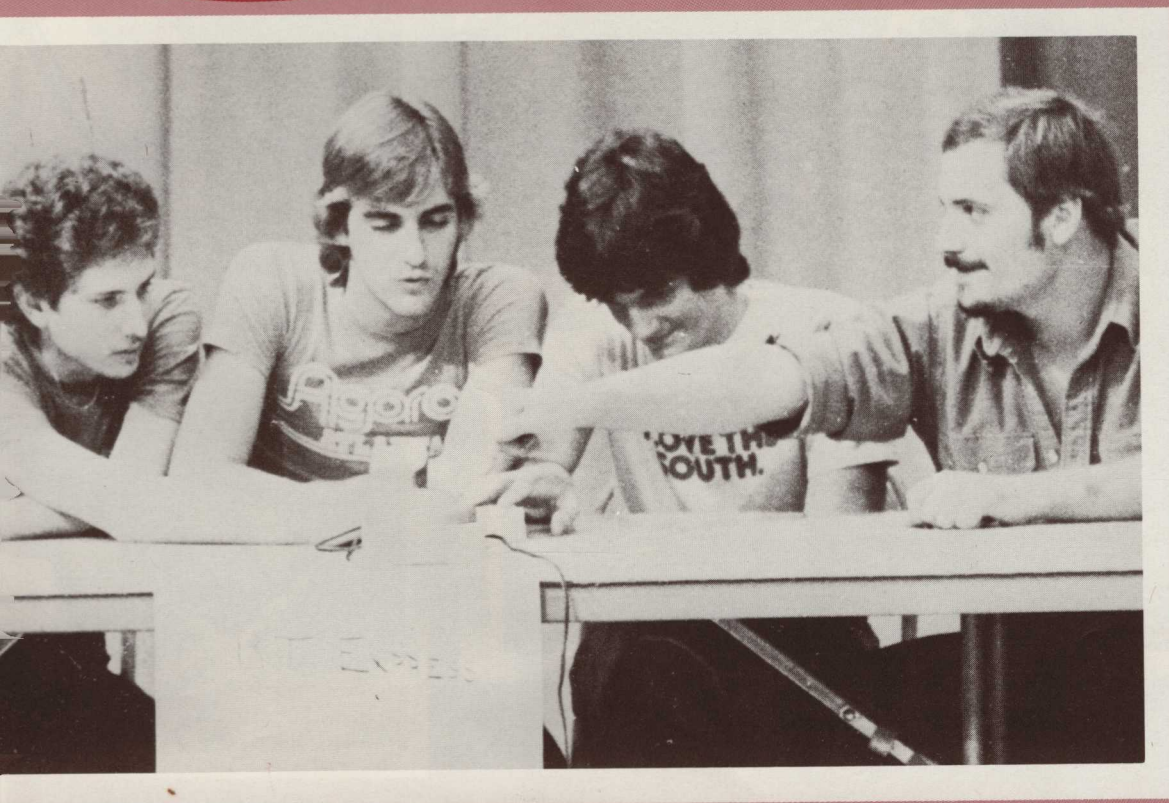
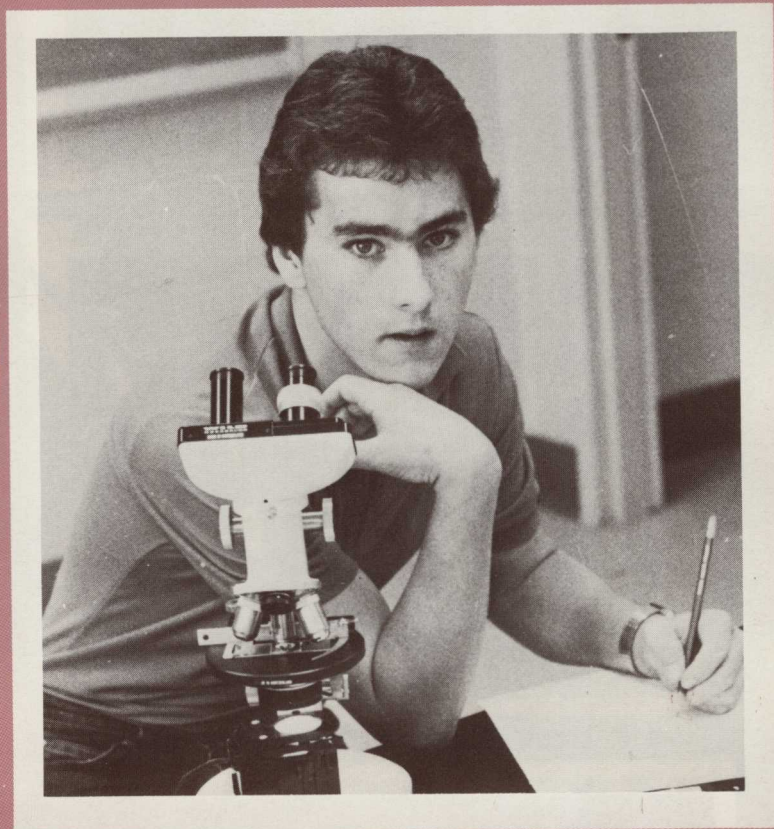


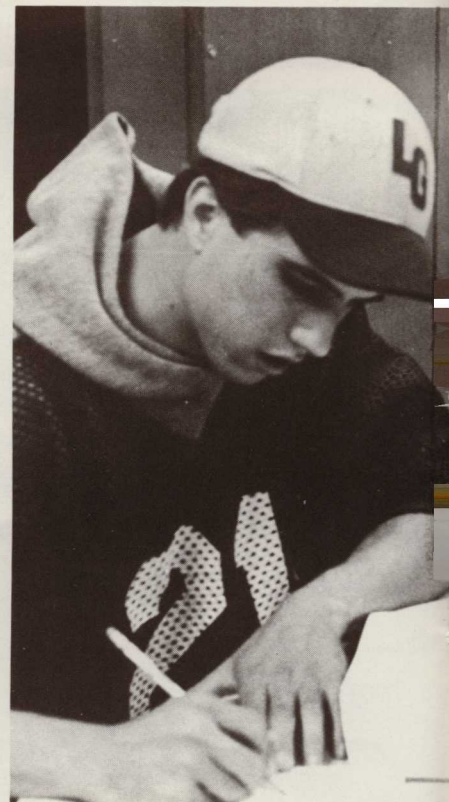

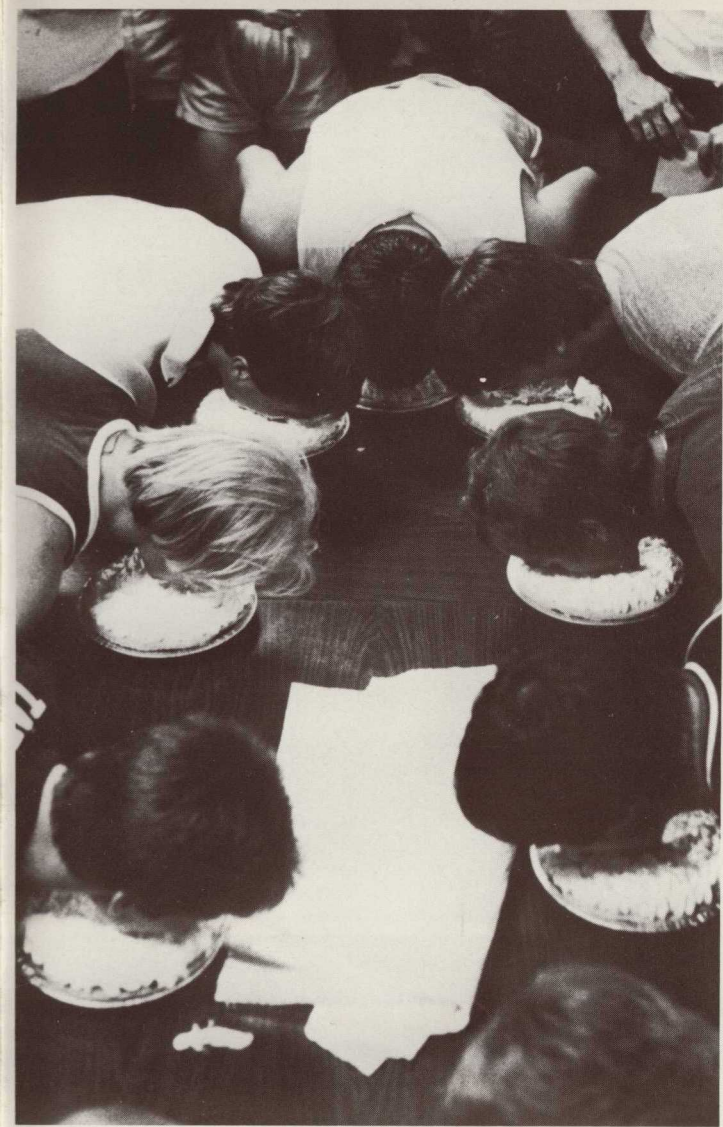


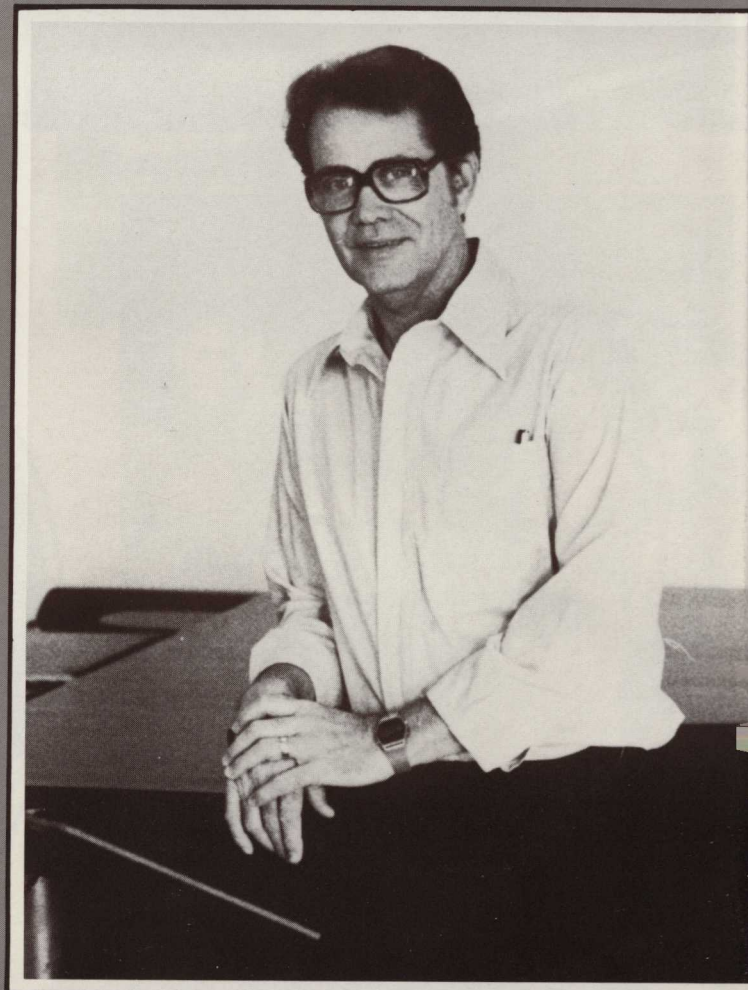
We learn from experience that life is what we make of it. The man who is true only to himself is nothing, for what is he without a friend? We begin to mature into individuals who can give as well as receive.

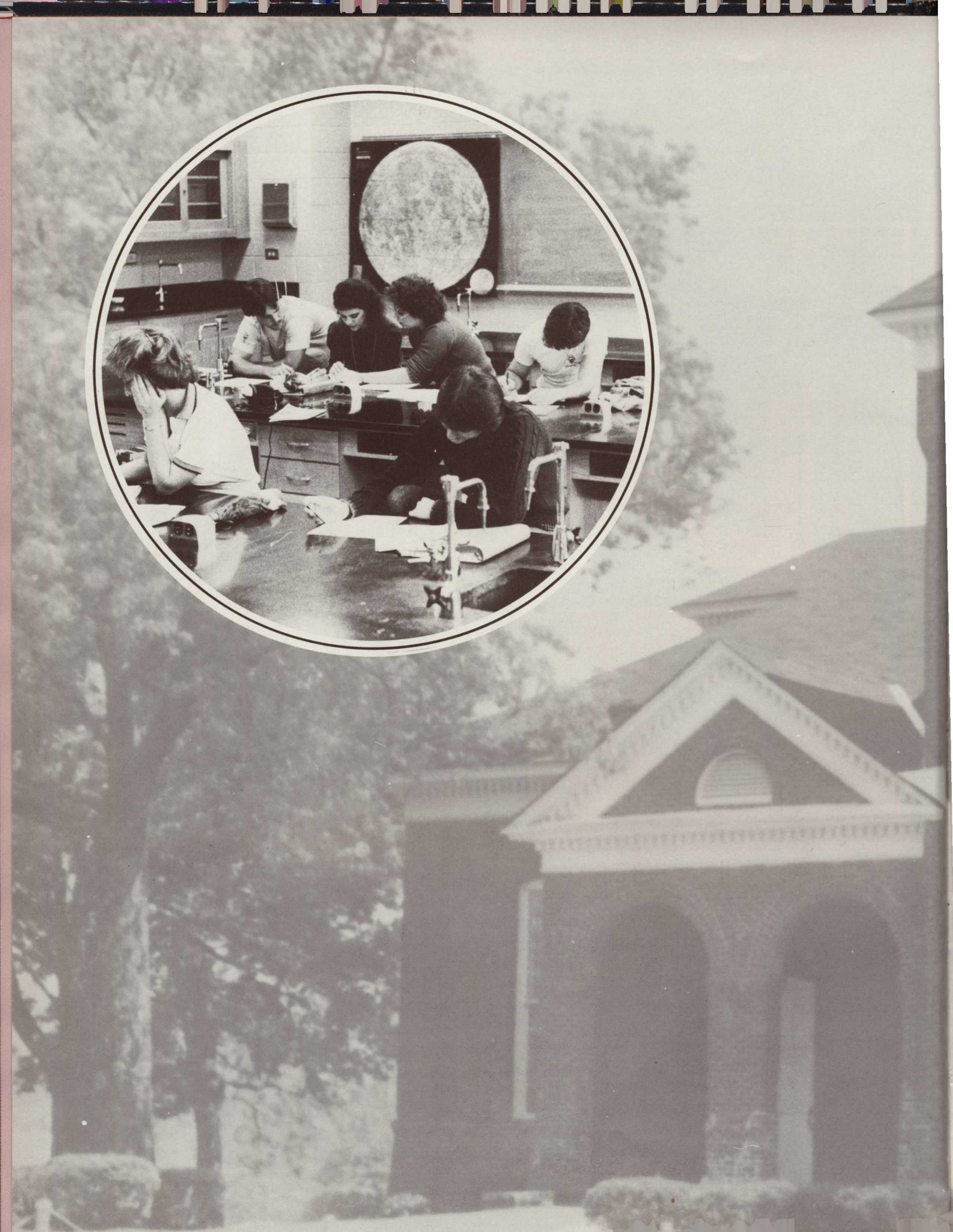

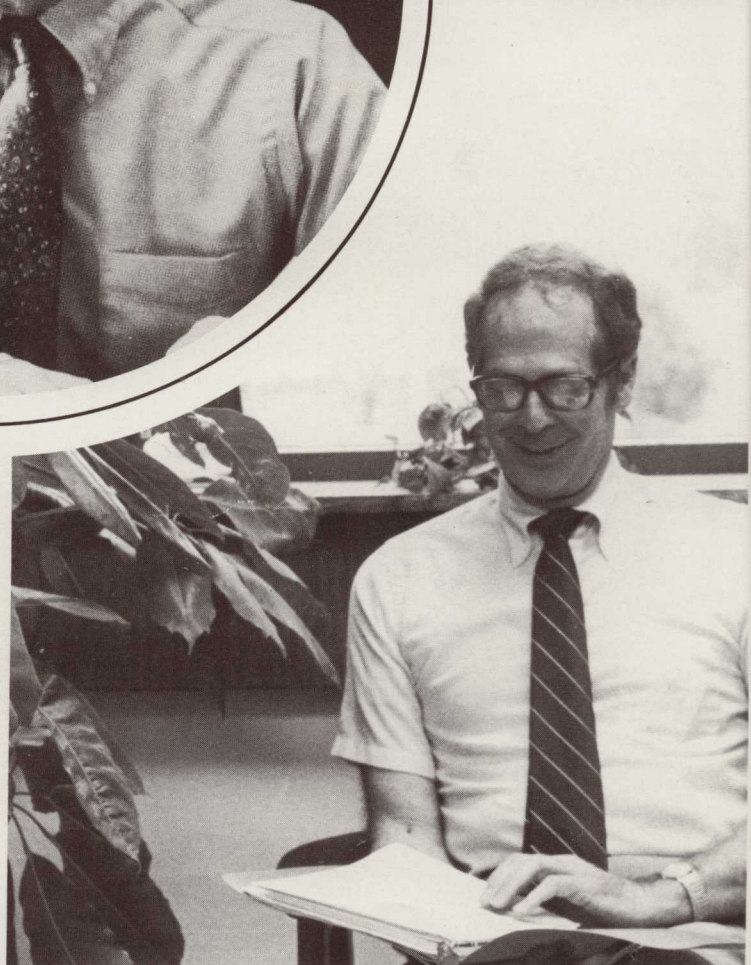
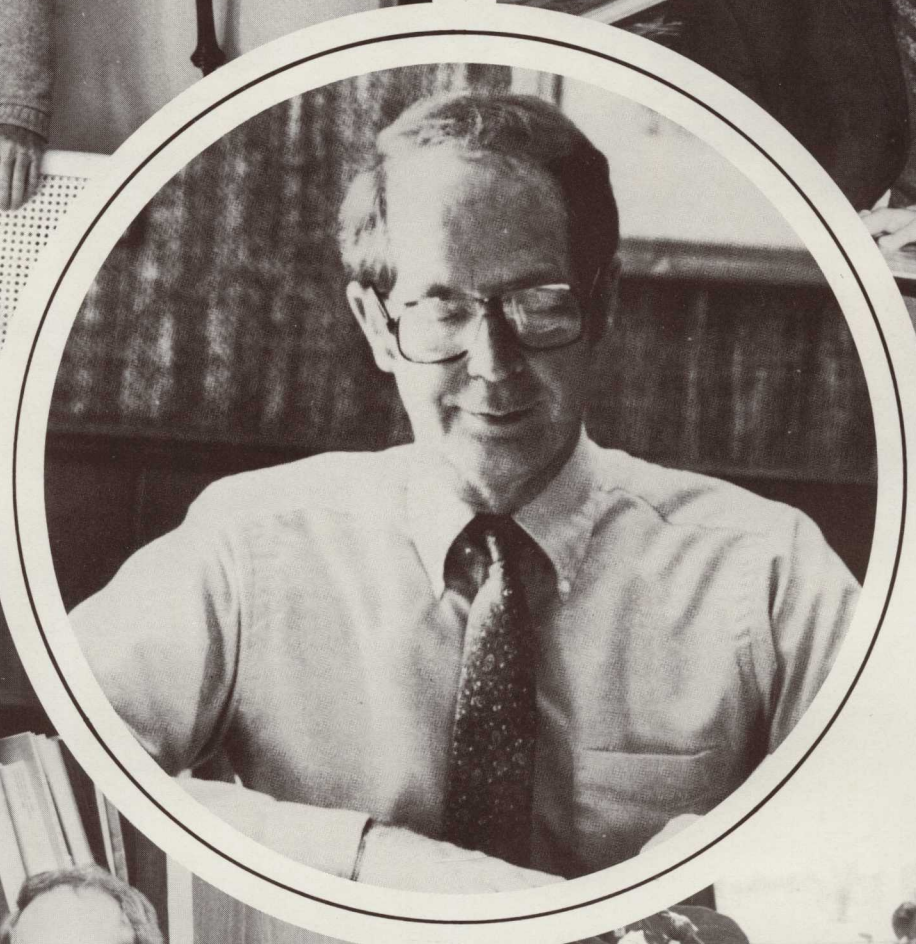

PRESIDENT: DR. RAY FARLEY

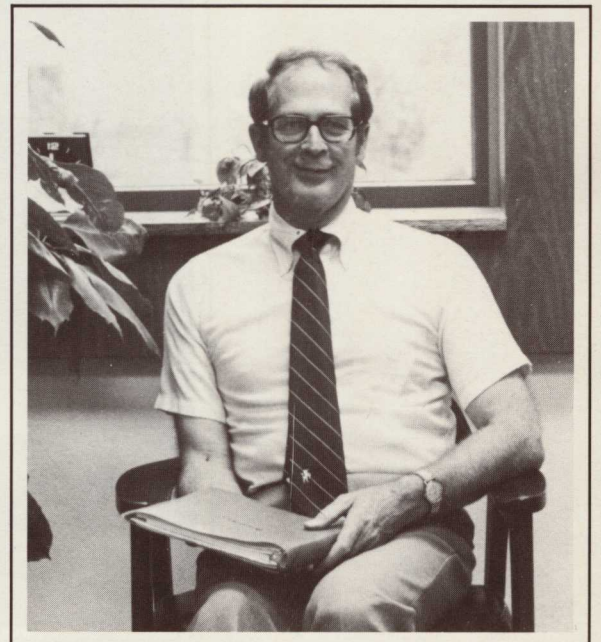


Ray Farley was born in West Virginia. At an early age the family moved to Tennessee where he received his education in the public schools and, subsequently, his Bachelor's Degree from Cumberland University, Lebanon, Tennessee, and his Master's Degree from George Peabody College for Teachers in Nashville, Tennessee. From 1952 to 1955 Dr. Farley was with the U.S. Army and during that period attended the Army Language School specializing in the Russian Language. In 1956 he accepted a position as Instructor of History at Young Harris College. He held this position until 1959 when as a Fulbright Scholar he attended the University Institute of European Studies in Turin, Italy, majoring in Modern European History. In the fall of 1959 he returned to Young Harris College as Dean of Instruction and Registrar. From 1961 to 1963 he attended Florida State University in Tallahassee, Florida as a University Fellow and as a Kellogg Fellow and received his Ph.D. in 1964. Returning to Young Harris College, Dr. Farley resumed his duties as Dean of Instruction and in 1967 was appointed Dean of the College in which position he remained until 1971 when he was elected President of Young Harris College.

Dr. Farley has served as President of the Georgia Association of Junior Colleges, Secretary-Treasurer of the Georgia Association of Private Colleges and Universities, a member of the Towns County Hospital Authority, a member of the Executive Committee of the Mountain Regional Library. He is a member of the University Senate of the United Methodist Church and is on the Board of Directors of the National Association of Schools and Colleges of the United Methodist Church. Dr. Farley has held many positions in the Methodist Church and is currently the lay leader of Sharp Memorial United Methodist Church in Young Harris.

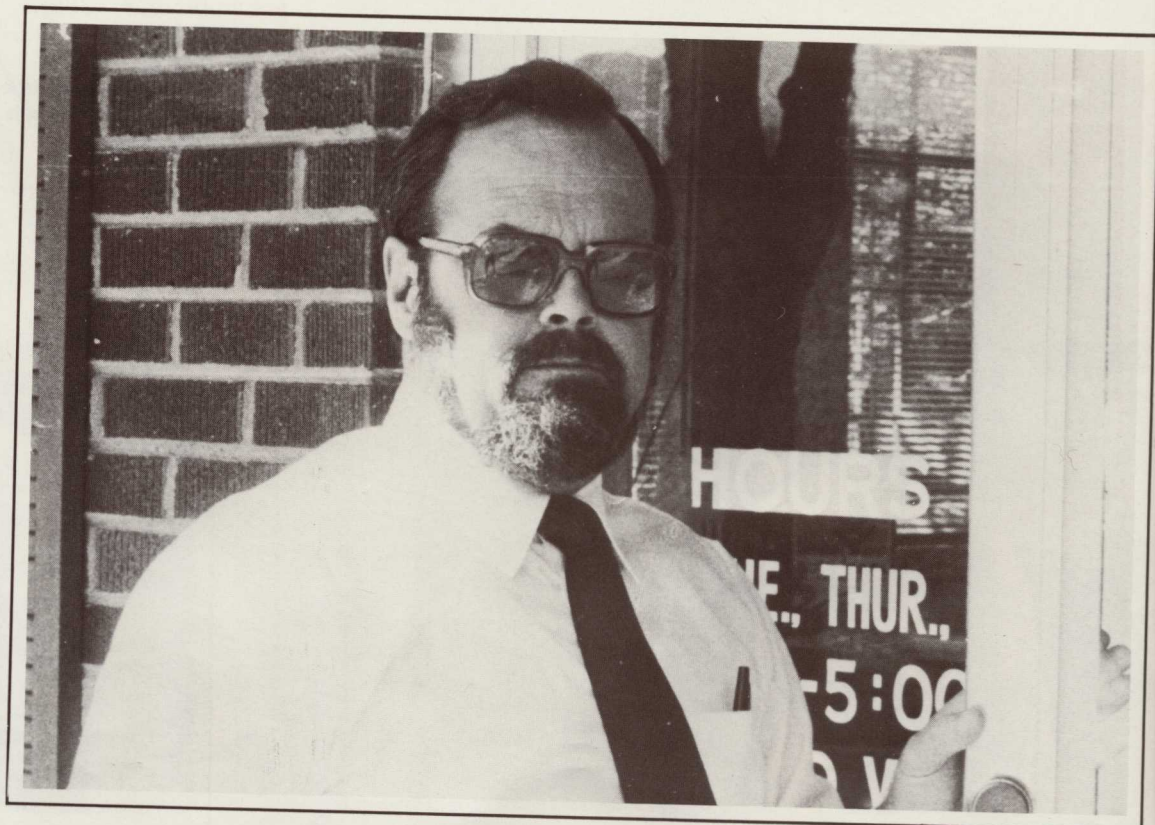
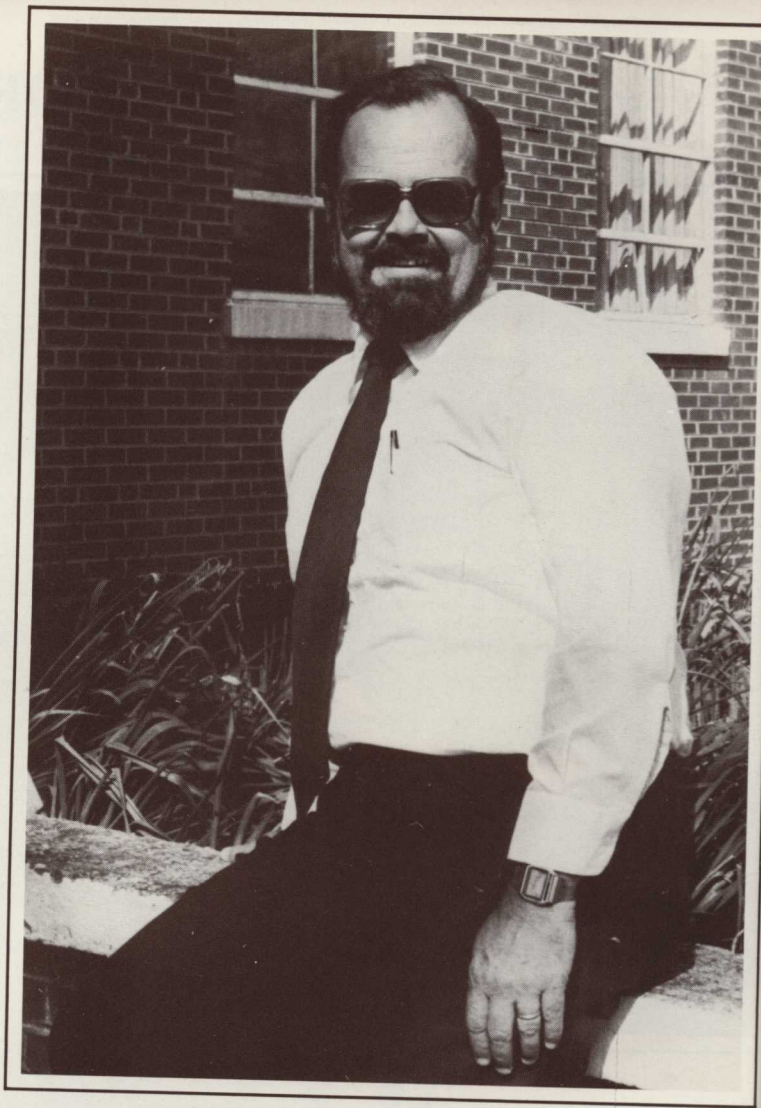

Dr. Farley is married to the former Blanche Flanders of Wrightsville, Georgia. They have a daughter, Susan.



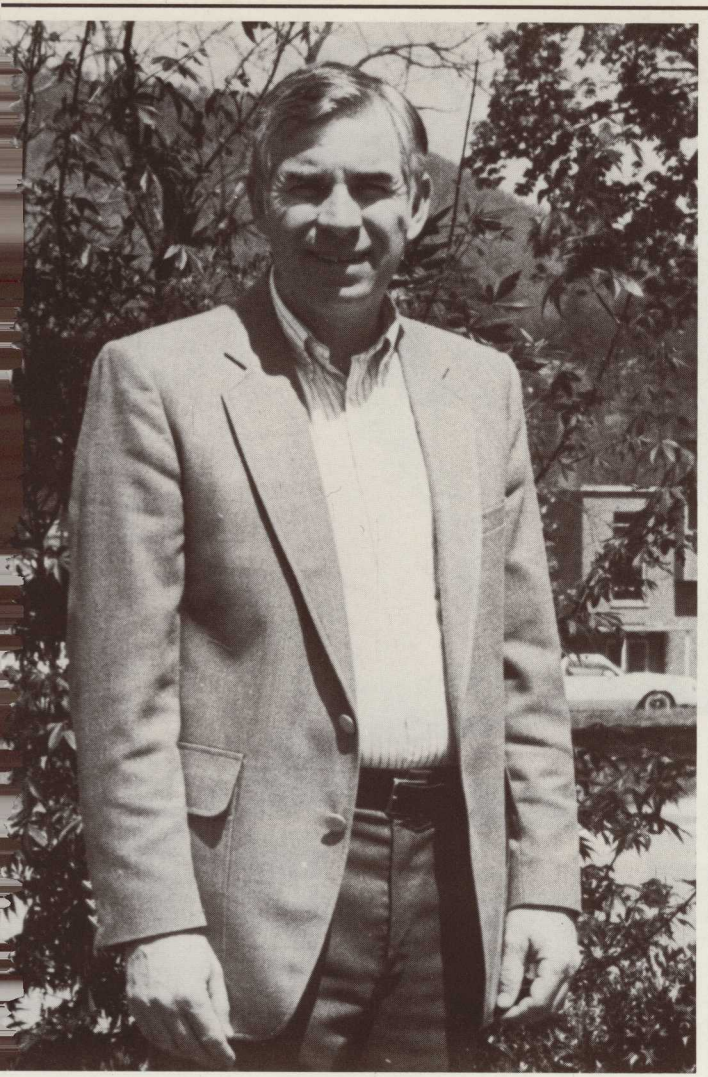
DEAN OF STUDENTS DR. JAMES HALE

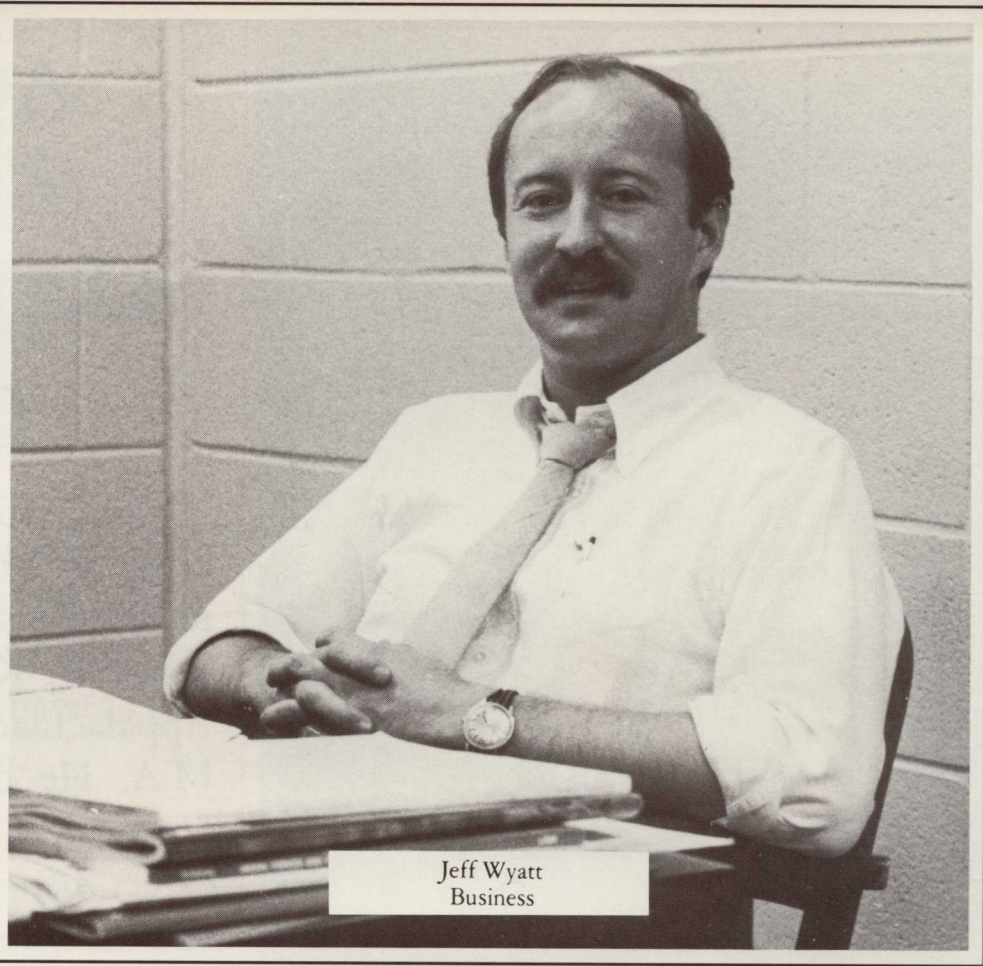


ACADEMIC DEAN DR. CLAY DOTSON

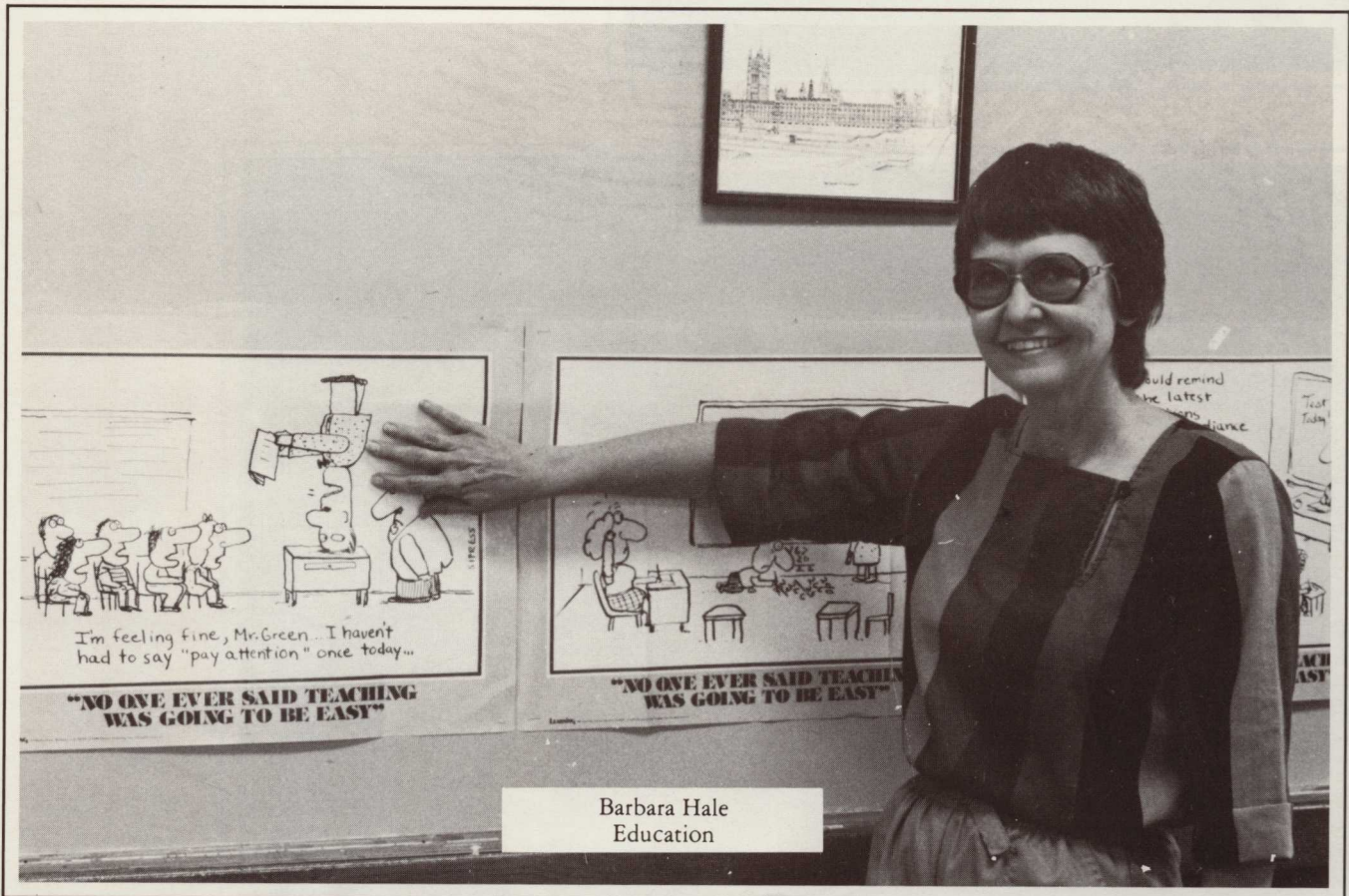

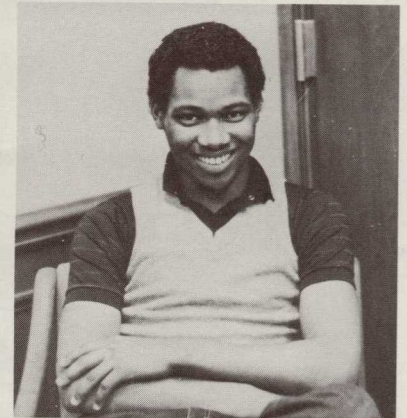
COUNCIL OF PRESIDENTS

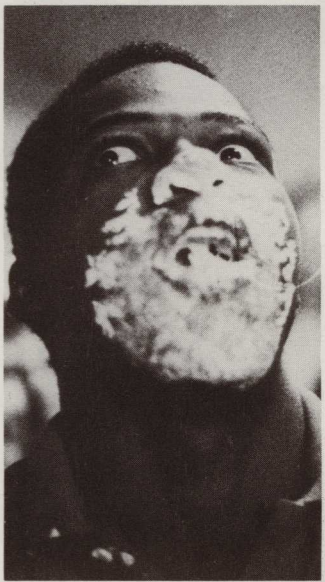

In the Spring of 1960, the Lamda Alpha Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa was installed on the campus of Young Harris College. Phi Theta Kappa is the national honorary scholastic fraternity for two year colleges, holding the same rank in junior colleges as Phi Beta Kappa holds in senior colleges. To become eligible for membership a student must demonstrate good character and meet one of the following grade-point requirements: attain a 4.0 grade-point average after completing 15 hours of academic credit; a 3.6 average after 30 hours; a 3.5 average after 60 hours, or a 3.3 average after 75 hours.

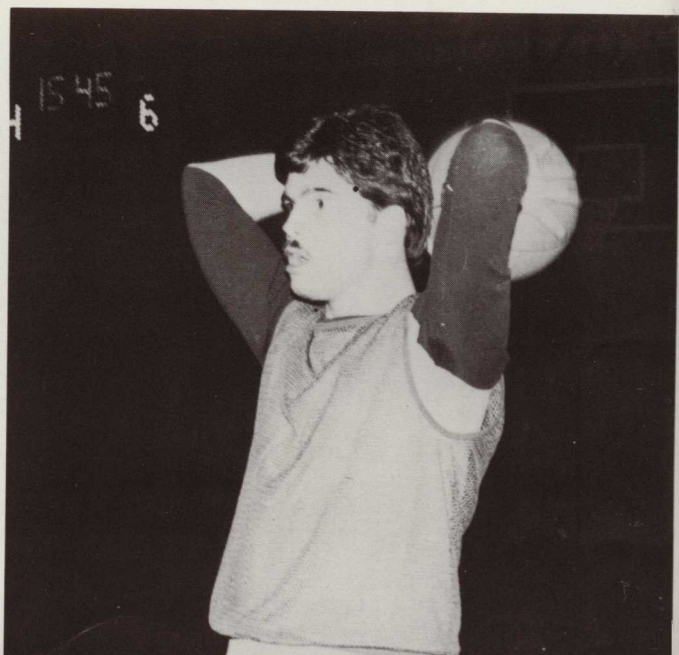
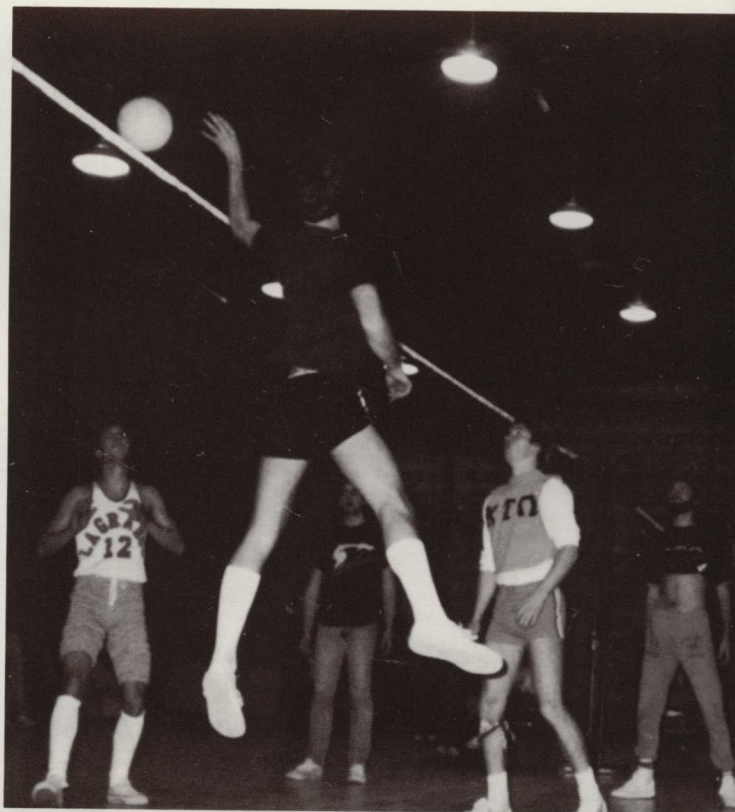


Young Harris College Intramurals

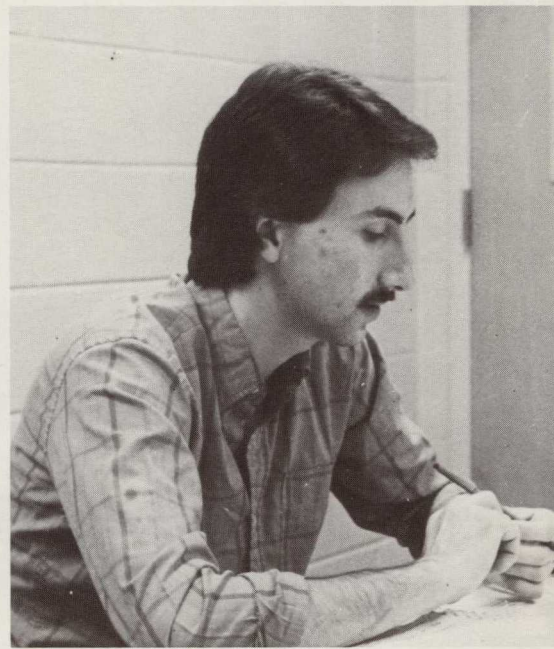
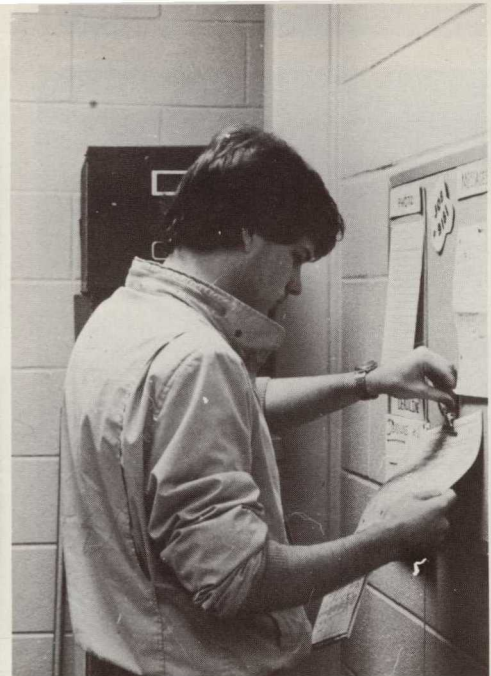
Finally, I would like to thank Mrs. Franklin for her help, advice, and friendship. She made this year a great experience for me.

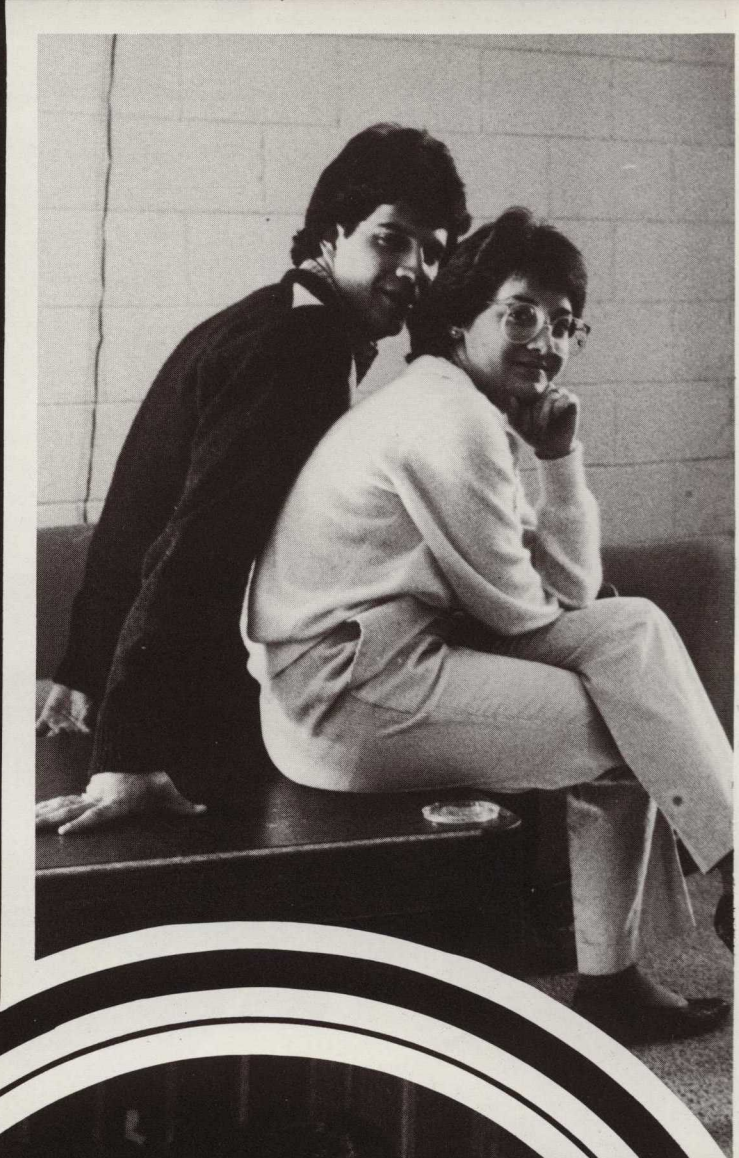
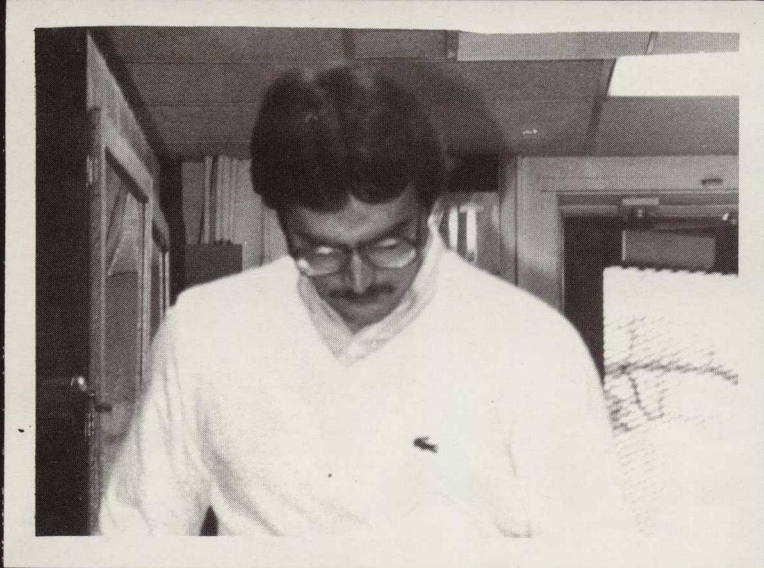

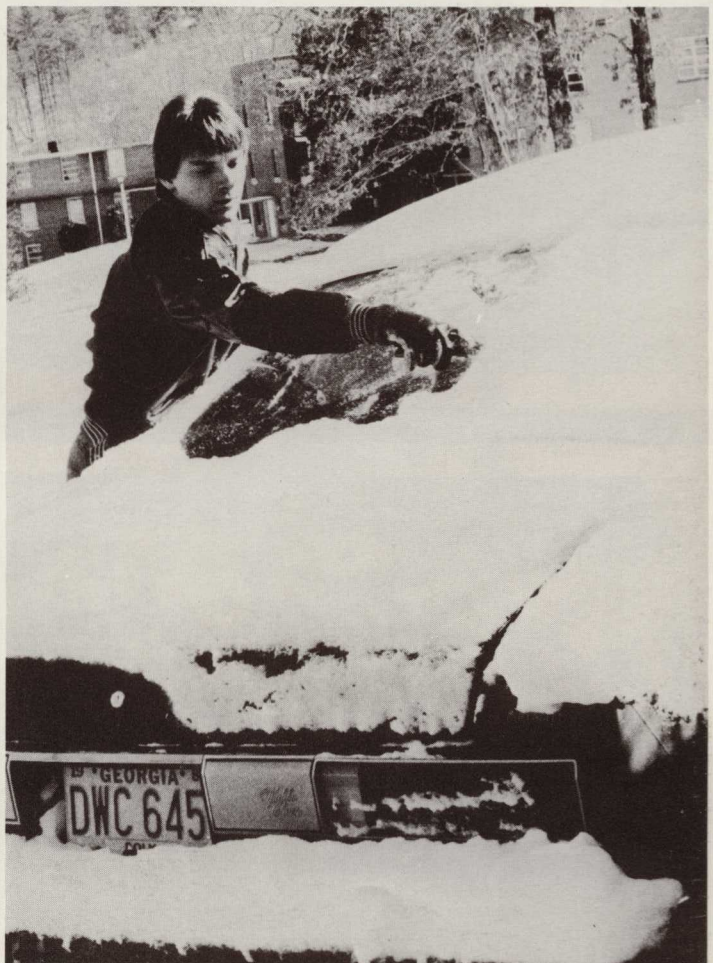
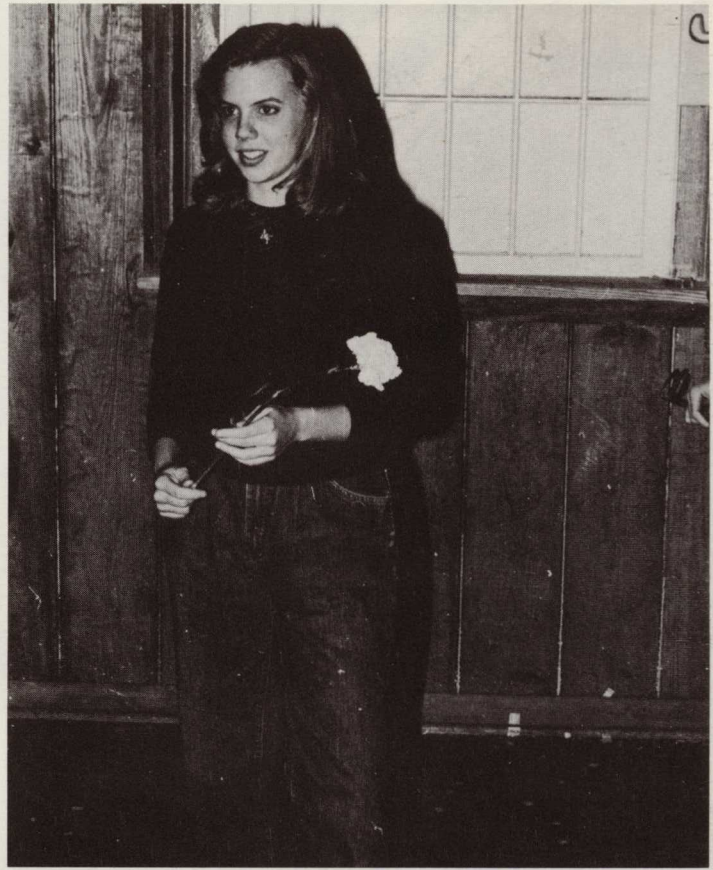
The Day After
